ITINERARY

- DAY I: Windhoek early meet & greet (pick up at accommodation) heading to Etosha Safari Camp, stay for two nights
- DAY 2: Etosha National Park for a full day adventures Safari
- DAY 3: Khowirab Schlucht Lodge from Etosha Camp we make our way to the Hobatere Consession via Kamanjab. Entering the uppper Hoanib River we head to the Lodge, in search for some desert Elephants
- Day 4: Hoarusib River wild camping towards Opuwo town via Juberts Pass, passing the Baobab tree forest. Entering the notorious Hoarusib River, looking for a comfertabel spot to set up our wild camp.
- Day 5: Puros community camp continuing down the great river on the look out for more desert Elephants we keep in the "flow of the river" passing through the Tonnesen & Giraffe Mountains, arriving at the Puros community campsite.

 Day 6: Ongongo Camp - leaving Puros crossing the great Gribisvlaktes into the Hoanib river we might see more Elephant's. This area is also home to the Hoanib adapted desert Lions. Destination - Ongongo Camp & Waterfalls. • Day 7: Sandstone Rock formations wild camp - leaving the beautiful waterfalls behind we head towards Palmwag, into the Huab River. Down the river we will set up our wild camp at the spectacular Sandstone Rock

• Day 8: Brandberg White Lady Lodge - heading into the Ugab River for our Ugab swamps challenge. Going up the River we will pass Namibias highest Mountain arriving at the White Lady Lodge.

• Day 9: Spitzkoppe Campsite - from the Lodge we make our way to the Spitzkoppe, Namibia's Matterhorn

• Day 10: The decision is yours - Swakopmund or Windhoek? Spitzkoppe taking us either direction we can head to the coastal town Swakopmund for one more final attraction or head back to Windhoek as our final



ETOSHA National Park

The Park is situated in the Northwestern Part of Namibia and is one of the largest national Parks in Africa. Etosha is home to hundreds of species of mammals, birds and reptiles, including several threatened and endangered species. We will spend nearly 2 days in the park, with our accommodations being right outside at the different gates. With luck we will see some Lions.









HOARUSIB Tophemeral River

This great River is situated in the Kunene Region of Namibia. Home to the majestic desert Elephants. The river has cut its way through the Tonnesen and Giraffe Mountains and is known for its steep canyon walls of black and red volcanic rock. Hoarusib – the name is thought to have originated from the <u>Nama</u> word "!naruseb", meaning "water which twists and turns through a narrow gorge












ONGONGO WATERFALLS Ongongo Camp

In the far North-West of Namibia we will reach the Ongongo Waterfalls / Camp. The small "nature pool" is hidden in a barren landscape in a small canyon. Make sure to take a dip and cool off in this magical setting.









The Lodge is situated in the Damaraland, 2km away from Namibias biggest Mountain – the Brandberg. The campsites are close to the riverbed of the Ugab river which we will drive through, getting to our destination on the lookout for the Desert Elephants. At the lodge, go grab yourself one of the best Milkshakes and have a dip in the pool.










SPITZKOPPE Camp Site
