

ITINERARY

- **DAY 1:** Windhoek to Fritzposten meet & greet, then we go grocery shopping and head to our first camp in the Khomas Hochland area.
- **DAY 2:** Fritzposten to Oasis Camp leaving Hochland behind we head into the Namib desert via the Spreetshoogte pass stoping at Solitaire, known for its Apple Pie. We continue to the Oasis Camp.
- **DAY 3:** Oasis Camp to Rostock Ritz Lodge starting very early we go for our Excursion to the famous Deadvlei in the Sossusvlei Park. Afterwards we head to Rockstock Ritz half way from the coast.
- **Day 4:** Rostock Ritz to Swakopmund still in the Namib Desert we head to Swakopmund were we will have 2 nights.
- **Day 5:** Swakopmund use the day to relax, explore the town or book any fun activities that will be available.
- **Day 6:** Swakopmund to Spitzkoppe leaving the coast behind our next stop is the Spitzkoppe Camp also known as Namibias Matterhorn.
- **Day 7:** Spitzkoppe to White Lady Lodge heading into our first big ephemeral river known as the Ugab, to get to our next destination.

- **Day 8:** White Lady Lodge to Huab River wild camp back into the Ugab River which is home to the desert adapted elephants, keep your eyes open for them. We head down the river continue ing to the Huab river valley were we will have our first wild camp.
- **Day 9:** Huab River to Ongongo Waterfalls leaving the wild camp up the hub river we head to the beautiful Ongongo Waterfalls for 2 nights.
- **Day 10:** From Ongongo we will make a day trip into the Hoanib river in search of wildlife and elephants.
- Day 11: Ongongo Waterfalls to Etosha National Park we have a long days drive ahead of us, but will be rewarded as we have 2 nights at Etosha National Park
- Day 12: Get ready for a full day Safari in the National Park.
- **Day 13:** Etosha to Windhoek its time to head back to Windhoek where we will have our last night with a farewell dinner and a recap of the exciting trip we had.
- Day 14: Fly out back home, with beautiful new memories made.

SOSSUSVLEI PARK the famours Deadwlei


Sossusvlei is situated in the largest conservation area in Africa - Namib-Naukluft National Park. The vlei is characterised by the large red dunes that surround a white, salt and clay pan and is a great destination all year round.

Deadvlei, which is close to Sussusvlei is a clay pan characterised by dark, dead camel thorn trees contrasted against the white pan floor. Be prepared to climb the great Dune at the Vlei.










SWAKOPMUND Coastat Ogyle

The small coastal town is situated on the western banks of the Atlantic Ocean on the edge of the Namib Desert. The town is characterised by 19th century German colonial architecture, founded in 1892 as the main harbour town back then. Enjoy the day with some leisure activities or just realx and breath in the fresh ocean air.











SPITZKOPPE

The magnificent Spitzkoppe, also known as the "Matterhorn of Namibia" is a 1728 m high archipelago mountain.

Enjoy your first night here, and be prepared for great views, and amazing granite rock formations.







BRANDBERG Mite Indy Lodge

The Lodge is situated in the Damaraland, 2km away from Namibias biggest Mountain – the Brandberg. The campsites are close to the riverbed of the Ugab river which we will drive through, getting to our destination on the lookout for the Desert Elephants. At the lodge, go grab yourself one of the best Milkshakes and have a dip in the pool.









ONGONGO WATERFALLS

Ongongo Camp

In the far North-West of Namibia we will reach the Ongongo Waterfalls / Camp. The small "nature pool" is hidden in a barren landscape in a small canyon. Make sure to take a dip and cool off in this magical setting.





ETOSHA Mational Park

The Park is situated in the Northwestern Part of Namibia and is one of the largest national Parks in Africa. Etosha is home to hundreds of species of mammals, birds and reptiles, including several threatened and endangered species. We will spend nearly 2 days in the park, with our accommodations being right outside at the different gates. With luck we will see some Lions.
