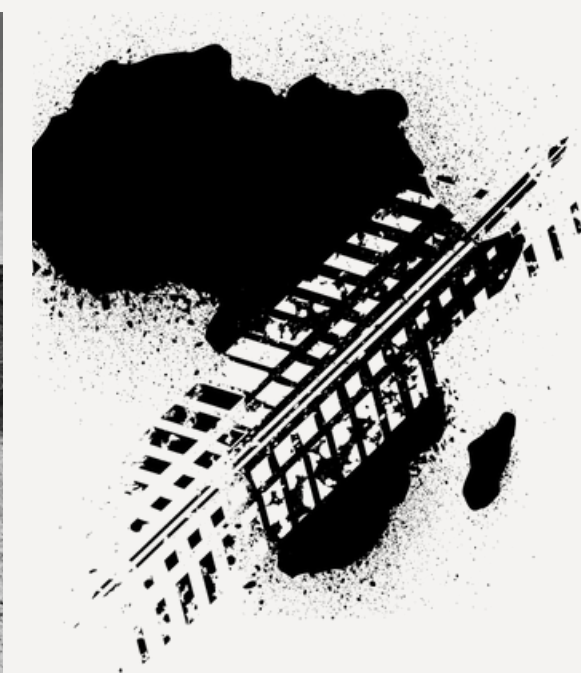

ITINERARY

- **DAY 1:** Windhoek to Spitzkoppe
- **DAY 2:** Spitzkoppe to Brandberg White Lady Lodge, through the Ugab River looking for Elephants
- **DAY 3:** White Lady Lodge over Dunes Cruiser Hill to wild camp at Backen Zahn Amphi Theater
- **Day 4:** Backen Zahn through the Huab River to Khowarib Schlucht Camp
- **Day 5:** Khowarib Schlucht into the Hoanib River looking for Elephants to Puros
- **Day 6:** Puros Camp to Marble Camp, through the great Stone Man area
- **Day 7:** Marble Camp to Opuwo Kaoko Mopane Camp
- **Day 8:** Kaoko Mopane Camp to Epupa Falls, stay for 2 nights
- **Day 9:** Epupa Falls Day Trip to Himba Village with Waterfall hike
- **Day 10:** Epupa Falls up the Kunene River to Opuwo, Kaoko Mopane Camp
- **Day 11:** Opuwo to beautiful Ongongo Waterfall
- **Day 12:** Ongongo to Ugab Terrace, hold your breath for the magnificent view
- **Day 13:** Ugab Terrace to Waterberg Plateau
- **Day 14:** Waterberg back to Windhoek for your final night
- **Day 15:** Windhoek back home with new memories made

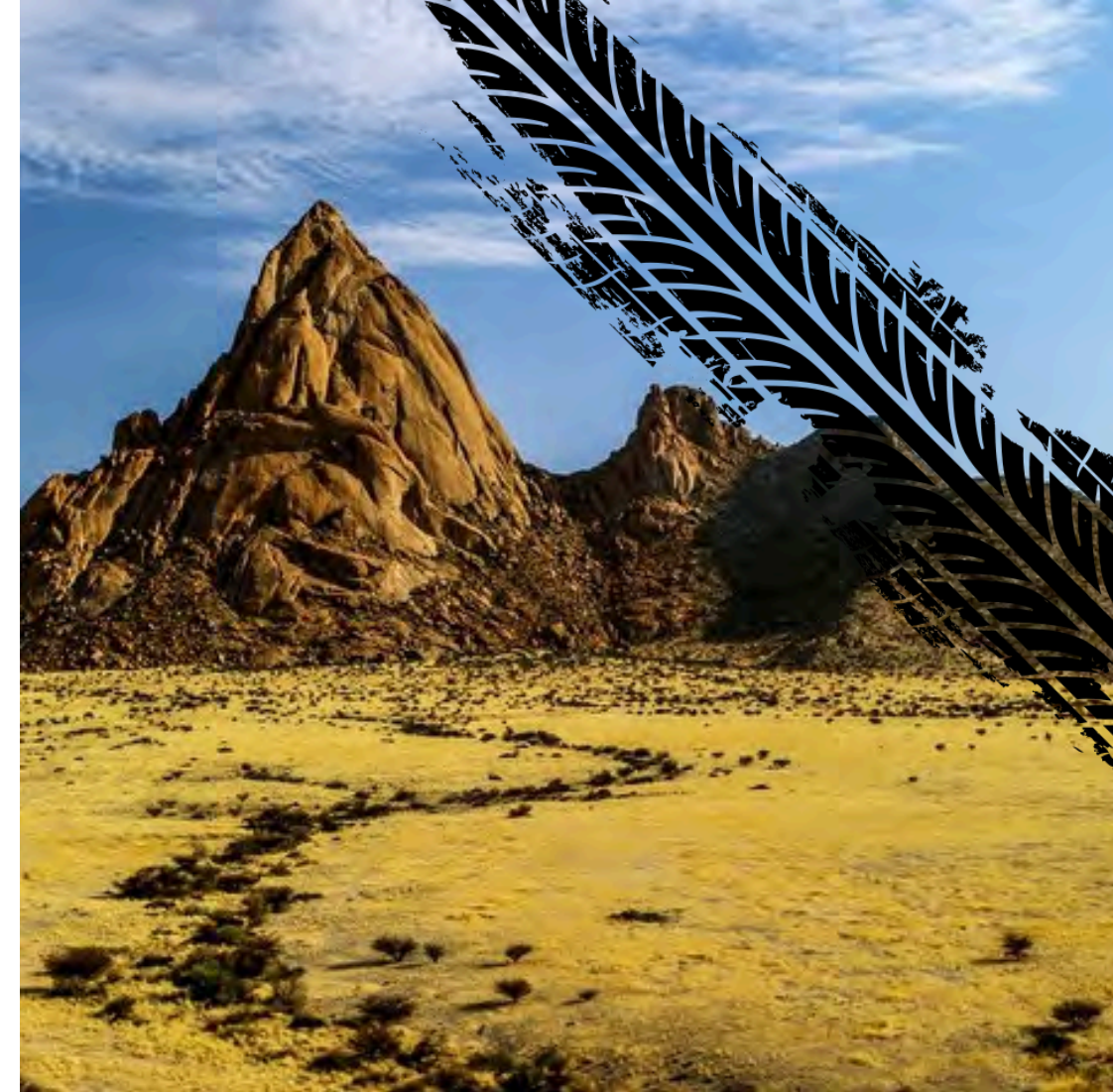
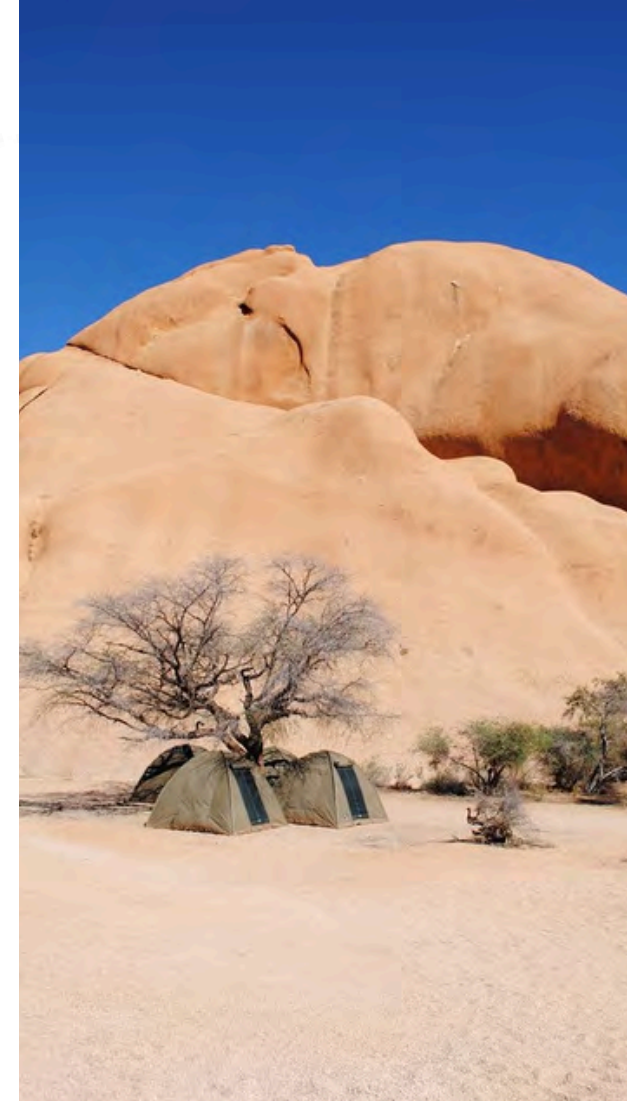


SPITZKOPPE

The magnificent Spitzkoppe, also known as the “Matterhorn of Namibia” is a 1728 m high archipelago mountain.

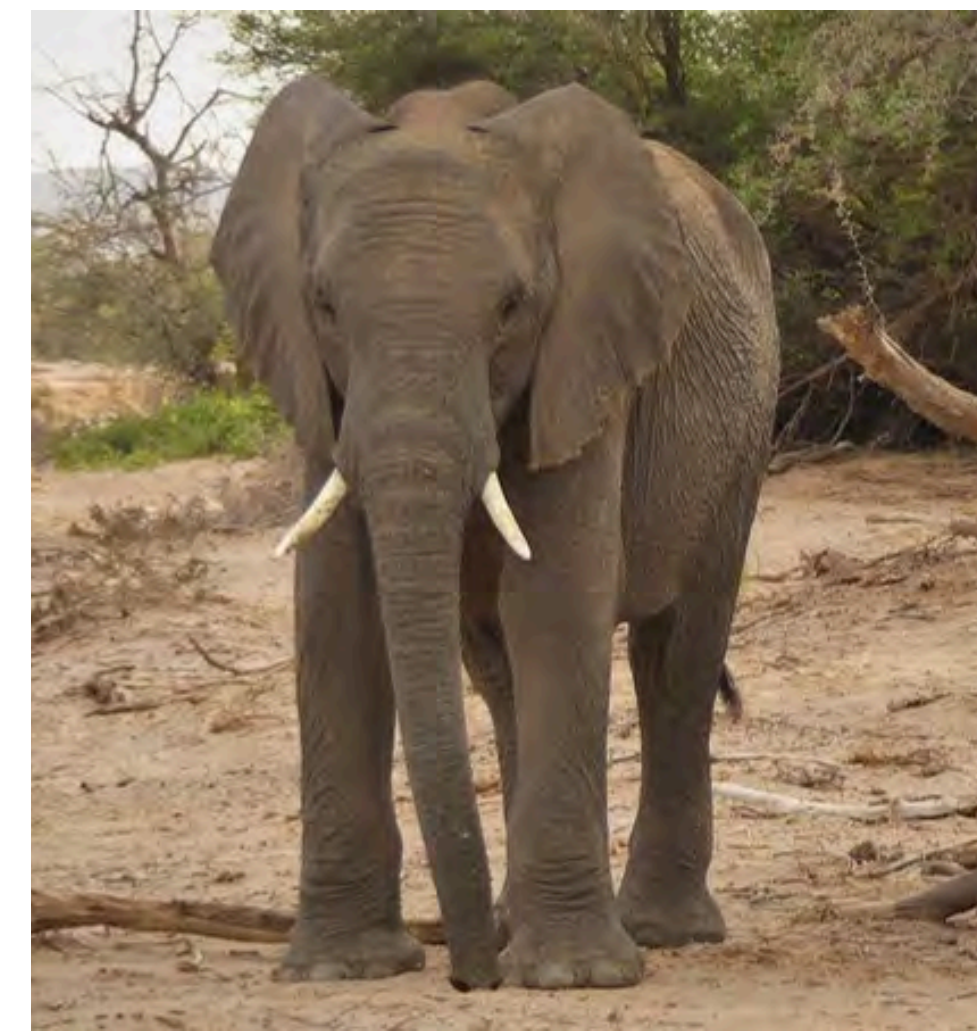
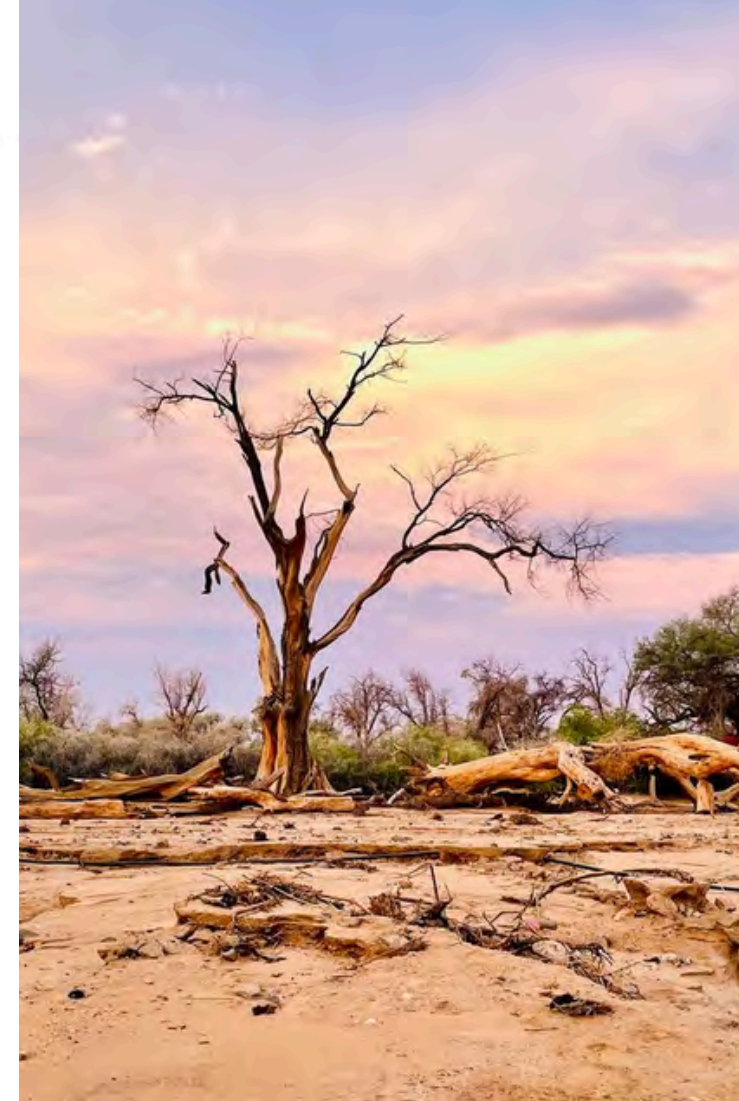
Enjoy your first night here, and be prepared for great views, and amazing granite rock formations.

White Lady Lodge

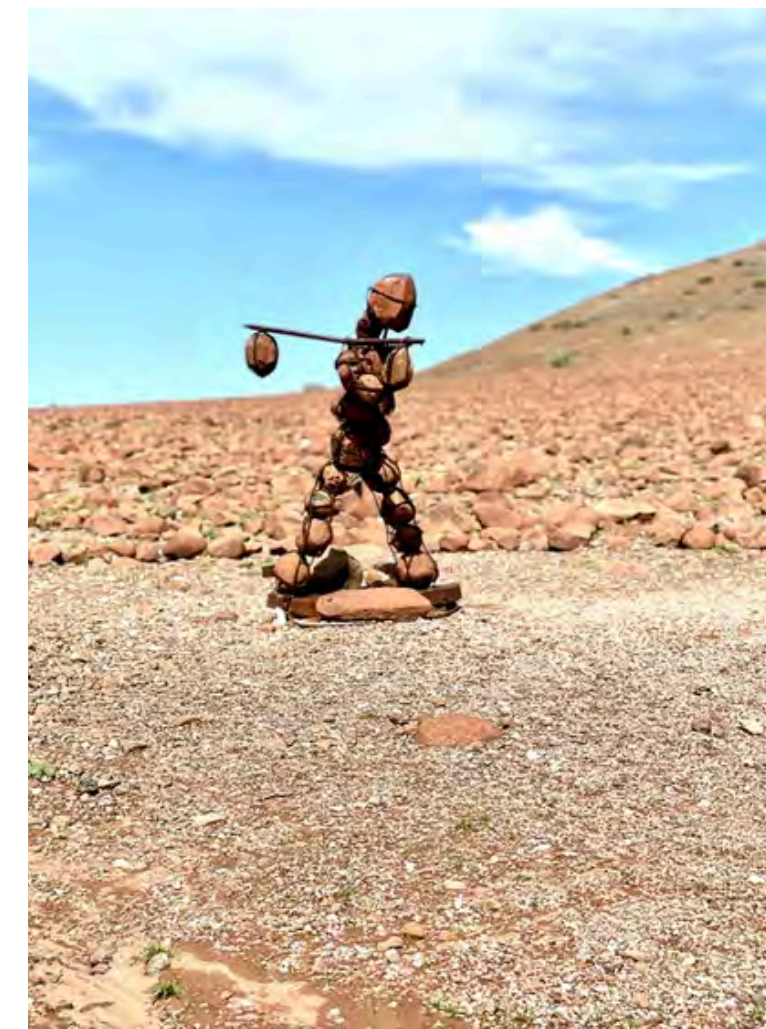
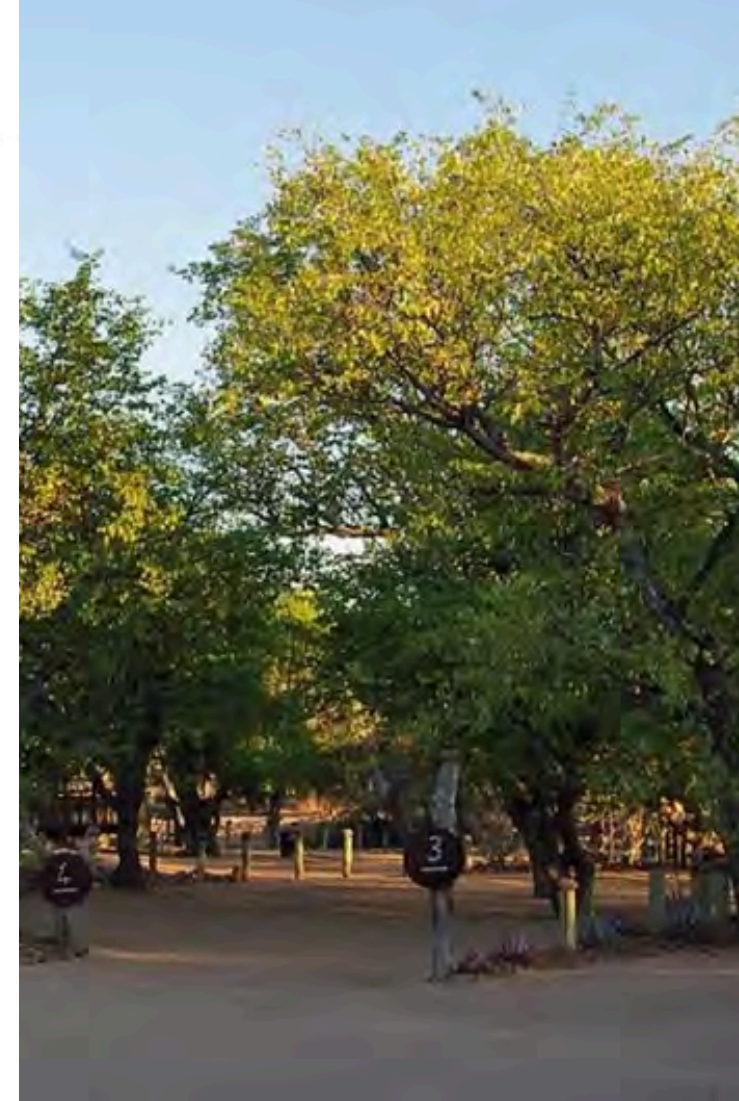

Marble Camp

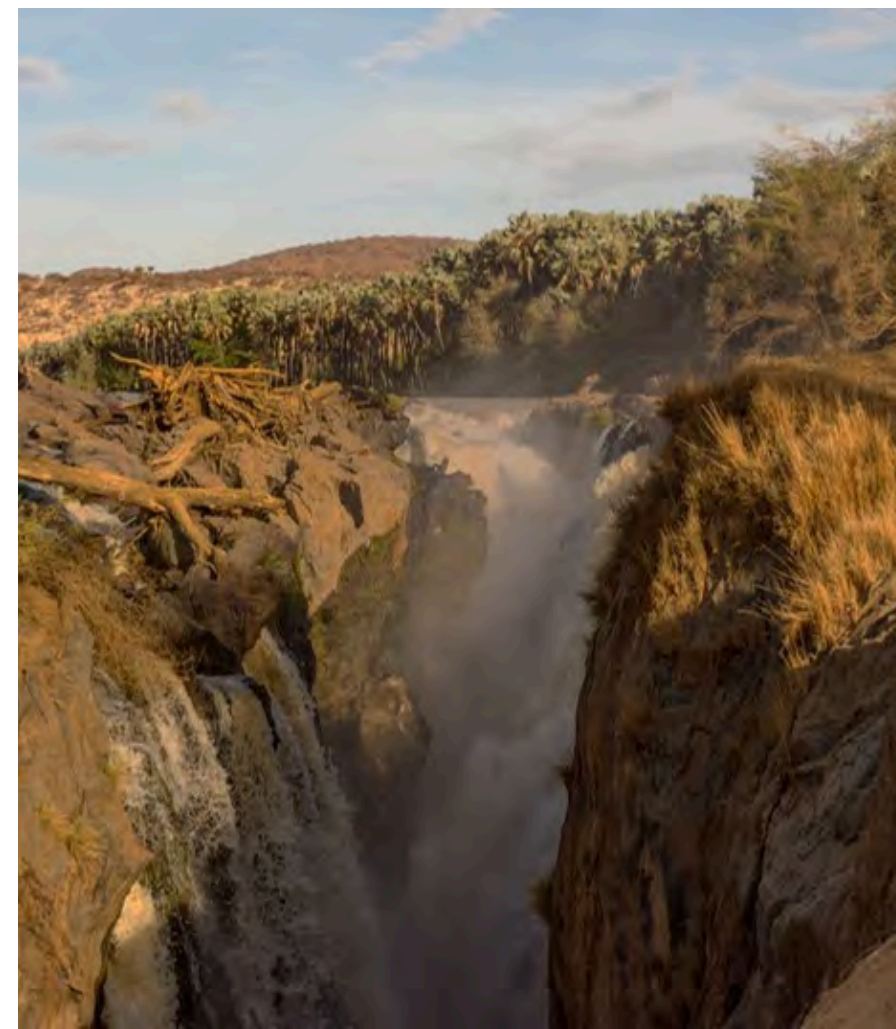
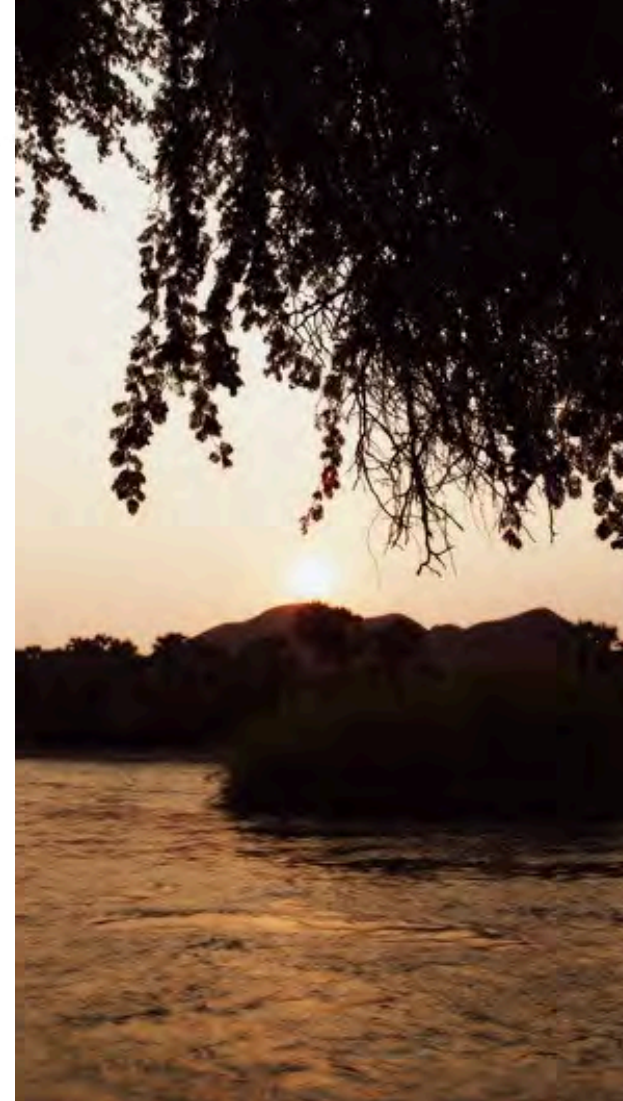
Driving through the Kaokoland, keep your eyes open for the Stone Men – the Lone Men of Namibia is a mystery wrapped up in an enigma. The men are scattered all over the country of Kaokoland. At the marble Camp, enjoy the tranquility or take a hike to the marble mine.



EPUPA FALLS

Epupa Camp

Close to the border of Namibia and Angola, we got to the Epupa Falls, a series of large waterfalls formed by the Kunene River. Here for two nights, there is enough time to explore unspoiled Land and visit a Himba village. And be on the look out for some crocodiles.



ONGONGO WATERFALLS

Ongongo Camp

In the far North-West of Namibia we will reach the Ongongo Waterfalls / Camp. The small “nature pool” is hidden in a barren landscape in a small canyon. Make sure to take a dip in this magical nature pool.



WATERBERG

Waterberg Plateau Campsite

In the central of Namibia, we reach the great Waterberg Plateau which elevates high above the Kalahari area, with a length over 50km.

Take in this great view and prepare yourself for a beautiful hike up the Plateau where we will track some Rhinos.
