# WINDHOEK TO PALM AFRIQUE LODGE (ROOM)



After your arrival in Windhoek, the capital of Namibia, we will meet you at the airport and warmly welcome you to our shared adventure. After a short briefing, the first stage begins. We drive east, passing open savannahs, small villages, and the red shimmering plains of the Kalahari. At the border to Botswana, we complete the entry formalities together and continue our journey to Ghanzi.

Upon arrival at Palm Afrique Lodge, comfortable rooms, a friendly atmosphere, and your first evening in the bush await you. As the campfire burns and crickets chirp, we enjoy the start of our safari under a sparkling night sky.





# PALM AFRIQUE LODGE TO CENTRAL KALAHARI GAME RESERVE (CAMPING)



We leave Palm Afrique Lodge in Ghanzi and drive south into the heart of the Kalahari. The tar road gradually turns into sandy tracks as we approach the Central Kalahari Game Reserve, one of the largest and most remote protected areas in Africa. After completing the park formalities at the entrance, we continue into a vast landscape of open grasslands, fossil river valleys, and endless horizons.

This region offers a deep sense of calm, space, and a unique wilderness atmosphere. During the afternoon, we select a suitable campsite within the reserve and set up camp. Facilities are basic and enhance the authentic wilderness experience. In the evening, we sit around the campfire and enjoy the remarkable silence of the Central Kalahari.



# CENTRAL KALAHARI GAME RESERVE TO CAMELTHORN FARMSTEAD (CAMPING)

Today our route takes us out of the Central Kalahari Game Reserve towards Xhumaga. Once more, we cross the wide plains and sandy tracks of the Kalahari before leaving the protected area behind.

The landscape gradually changes, and as we get closer to the Boteti River, the vegetation becomes denser along the riverbanks.

In the afternoon, we arrive at Camelthorn Farmstead near Xhumaga, located on the banks of the Boteti River. Here we stay at the campsite in a peaceful riverside setting and end the day in a relaxed atmosphere.



# CAMELTHORN FARMSTEAD TO AUDI CAMP (CAMPING)



From Camelthorn Farmstead, we continue our journey at a relaxed pace towards Maun. The route passes through open farmland and wide plains, as the landscape gradually becomes flatter and more accessible.


As we approach Maun, there is a noticeable increase in activity before we reach the town and continue to our accommodation. In the afternoon, we arrive at Audi Camp, beautifully situated along the Thamalakane River. Here we set up camp and enjoy a relaxed evening by the water, a pleasant transition between wilderness and civilisation.



# AUDI CAMP TO MOREMI SOUTH GATE (CAMPING)

From Maun, we set off towards the Moremi Game Reserve. The route begins on tar road before we switch to sandy tracks as we gradually approach the reserve. At South Gate, we complete the park formalities and then continue into the reserve. With every kilometre, the feeling of civilisation fades and the wilderness takes over. In the afternoon, we arrive at Moremi South Gate and set up our camp. Facilities are simple and practical, in line with a true wilderness experience. In the evening, we gather around the campfire and enjoy the unique atmosphere in the heart of the Okavango Delta.





## MOREMI SOUTH GATE TO XAKANAXA (CAMPING)



From South Gate, our route takes us deeper into the Moremi Game Reserve. The drive follows the well-known sections of First Bridge, Second Bridge, and Third Bridge, sandy tracks and wooden bridges that lead through varied landscapes of mopane forests, lagoons, and open plains.

Along the way, we take time for short stops and enjoy the unique atmosphere of this region. The drive itself is part of the experience and gives a true sense of safari. In the late afternoon, we reach Xakanaxa Camp, beautifully located near waterways and lagoons. Here we set up camp and spend the evening surrounded by the calm and natural beauty of the Okavango Delta.



# XAKANAXA TO MAGOTHO CAMP (CAMPING)



After breakfast, we continue our journey towards Khwai. The landscape begins to change. Wet floodplains give way to dry savannahs, where giraffes and zebras graze. Our destination is Mogocho Camp, beautifully set along the Khwai River. Here we set up camp under shady acacia trees. With a bit of luck, elephants may pass along the riverbanks as we enjoy the sunset. A place where you truly feel the wilderness in its purest form.



# MAGOTHO TO SAVUTI (CAMPING)



We continue to Savuti, one of Botswana's most famous wildlife areas. The drive itself feels like a game drive, as we cross animal paths, waterholes, and open plains where herds of elephants, buffalo, zebras, and prides of lions roam. Every turn can bring a new encounter, perhaps a hyena moving between the acacia trees or an eagle circling above the Savuti Marsh.

The camp is set in the heart of the Savuti plains, a place where the wilderness feels close and the sounds of the night are clear. An unforgettable experience for true adventurers.






# SAVUTI TO CHOBE SAFARI LODGE (ROOM)

Today's stage takes us from Savuti further north towards Kasane. We leave the open plains and sandy tracks of the Savuti area and travel through the varied landscapes of Chobe National Park. As we get closer to the Chobe River, the surroundings begin to change, with denser vegetation and a clear sense of entering a water-rich region. In the afternoon, we arrive at Chobe Safari Lodge in Kasane. Here we stay in comfortable rooms near the river. After several days of camping, this is a good opportunity to relax, take a shower, and enjoy the lodge facilities.





## DAY TRIP TO VICTORIA FALLS



Today features a special highlight, a trip to the Victoria Falls, known as “Mosi-oa-Tunya”, the smoke that thunders. We cross the border into Zimbabwe and experience this powerful natural wonder up close. The roar of the water, the fine mist, and the rainbows above the gorge make this day unforgettable. In the late afternoon, we return to Kasane and enjoy a relaxed evening.



# CHOBÉ SAFARI LODGE TO NAMBWA CAMP (CAMPING)



From Kasane, the journey takes us back into Namibia and into the Zambezi Region. After completing the border formalities, we continue along the Caprivi Strip, passing villages, forests, and wide river landscapes. The route leads us into a green and water-rich region that contrasts strongly with the drier areas of Botswana. The presence of rivers shapes the scenery and creates a calm and relaxed atmosphere along the way.

In the afternoon, we arrive at Nambwa Camp. Here we set up camp and spend the night at the campsite, surrounded by the nature of the Zambezi Region. We end the day in a peaceful setting.

# NAMBWA TO RAINBOW RIVER LODGE (CAMPING)



Today's stage takes us from Nambwa further west through the Zambezi Region towards Divundu. The route passes through varied woodland landscapes and follows the Okavango River, passing small settlements and wide riverbanks that define this region. The scenery feels both calm and alive, shaped by the water and daily life along the river.

In the afternoon, we arrive at Rainbow River Lodge. Here we set up camp, surrounded by nature right by the river. In the evening, we enjoy the peaceful atmosphere along the Okavango and end the day relaxed around the campfire.



# RAINBOW RIVER LODGE TO KHAUDUM NORTH (CAMPING)



From Divundu, our route leads us into one of Namibia's most remote regions, the Khaudum National Park. The track becomes increasingly sandy and demanding, and we gradually enter a raw and untouched wilderness. The drive requires focus and teamwork, as deep sand and narrow tracks set the pace. Along the way, we enjoy the isolation and vastness of this rarely visited area.

In the afternoon, we arrive at Khaudum North and set up camp. Facilities are very basic, which adds to the true wilderness experience. In the evening, we gather around the campfire and experience the unique silence of this remote national park.





# KHAUDUM NORTH NACH KHAUDUM SOUTH (GLAMPING)


Today we cross the park from north to south, a true off-road stage with exciting wildlife sightings along the way. We drive slowly through the savannah and keep an eye out for herds of elephants, giraffes, and perhaps even lions moving through the tall grass.

In the afternoon, we reach our comfortable tented camp in the southern part of the park. After a warm shower and a delicious dinner, we enjoy the evening around the campfire. Above us, a sky full of stars shines clearly, untouched by the presence of civilisation.





# KHAUDUM SOUTH TO WATERBERG PLATEAU (CAMPING)



After an early breakfast, we set off and leave Khaudum heading west. The drive takes us through wide bush landscapes and small villages until the impressive Waterberg Plateau appears on the horizon.

In the afternoon, we join a guided rhino tracking walk with experienced rangers. Moving quietly through the bush, we experience these animals up close, a powerful moment and a true highlight of any Namibia journey. In the evening, we enjoy the view over the plains and the peaceful atmosphere at the foot of the plateau.



# WATERBERG TO HUAB DESOLATION VALLEY (CAMPING)



From the Waterberg Plateau, our route continues northwest into increasingly dry and rugged landscapes. The striking red cliffs of the Waterberg fade behind us as wide plains and open savannahs take over. As we approach Damaraland, the surroundings feel more raw and untouched. Gravel roads, vast horizons, and scattered farms define the journey. In the afternoon, we arrive at the Huab Desolation Valley. Here we set up camp in the middle of this dramatic and barren landscape. The silence, the open space, and the unique atmosphere of this remote valley make the evening a memorable experience under the open sky.



# HUAB WILD CAMP TO BRANDBERG (CAMPING)

After a night beneath a sky full of stars, we set off towards Brandberg, Namibia's highest mountain. The drive takes us through vast open spaces, dry riverbeds, and gently rising slopes until the striking silhouette of Brandberg appears in the distance.

In the afternoon, we arrive at White Lady Lodge. The sunset casts the mountain in warm red and golden light, a sight that stays with you.






# BRANDBERG TO WINDHOEK (ROOM)



From Brandberg, we begin our return journey towards Windhoek. The drive takes us through the wide landscapes of Damaraland, past open plains and striking rock formations, before we rejoin well-developed roads. With every kilometre, the capital comes closer and the scenery changes again, from rugged wilderness to farmed areas and gentle hills.

In the afternoon, we arrive in Windhoek and check in at Ti Melen. In the evening, we meet for a shared farewell dinner in a relaxed setting. We look back on the journey, share special moments and memories, and enjoy our final evening together before departure the next day.



# WINDHOEK CITY TOUR & DEPARTURE

On the final day, there is an optional city tour through Windhoek. You visit the Christ Church, the Alte Feste, the Craft Market, and Katutura. Afterwards, you are transferred to the airport. With many memories, new friendships, and a piece of Africa in your heart, we say goodbye.








